### PROBLEM

The city of Reykjavik spends millions of Krona on graffiti removal each year. They wanted a durable coating for easy graffiti removal.

### APPLICATION

This pedestrian tunnel runs under the intersection of Flugvallavegur and Hlidarfotur, which is close to Hotel Loftleidir (Icelandair hotels) by the Reykjavik airport. The tunnel is 115ft (35m) long, 13ft (4m) wide, and 8ft (2.4m) high. A total of 383 yd<sup>2</sup> (320m<sup>2</sup>) of concrete was coated with MCI® Anti Graffiti Coating. There were 9.5 gallons (36L) of coating applied to the structure with a special roller for the right coating thickness.

### CONCLUSION

The customer was very pleased with the ease of application and look of the coating on the concrete.
