Applicable on bridges, balconies, parking decks and ramps, civil-engineered structures, buildings, foundations, concrete piers, and offshore platforms, the coating can be applied, after power washing the surface, at low ambient temperatures with good adhesion. If applied to a surface such as the underside or side of a structure, a top coating is unnecessary, but if applied to the top, a traffic-bearing coating is needed. The fast-acting coating also offers 5 to 7 years of cathodic protection.
